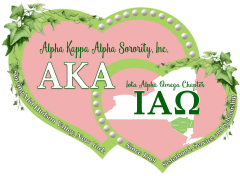

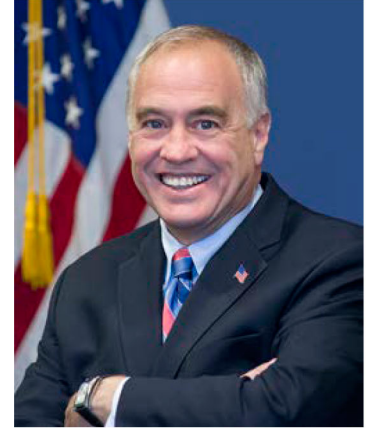

He is a graduate of the Culinary Institute of American in Hyde Park NY and has a range of professional experiences in the culinary arts. His experiences have been in renowned New York City restaurants along with traveling around the world to further expand on his global knowledge of culinary arts.

Chef Walker was drawn to Poughkeepsie NY and the Hudson Valley Region because of its rich culture of artisans. Immersing himself in the food scene, he has worked in some of the best local restaurants in the Hudson Valley and received numerous accolades for creating seasonal menus that uniquely displayed his cooking style, along with utilizing ingredients from local farmers and purveyors.

Chef Walker founded B&L Hospitality, Hudson Valley's premier restaurant group, in 2014. His mission is to "Create Memories with Exceptional Food and Service" through all of his restaurant concepts. In June 2016 Chef Walker opened Essie's restaurant. Essie's is a place that showcases his globally influenced cuisine but also pays homage to his grandmother and the women in his family who are great cooks and are the reason his interest in food was ignited. Since the opening of Essie's, Chef Walker has received reviews and accolades from the Poughkeepsie Journal, Hudson Valley Network News, Khaleej Times, Parlour Magazine, Daily Voice, Chronogram, Edible Hudson Valley, Verizon FiOS Restaurant Hunters, and Best of the Hudson Valley 2017 from Hudson Valley Magazine for delivering outstanding food and service.

Chef Walker believes in his community and gives back by getting involved with local profit and non-profit organizations. Annually he educates a women's group that focuses on improving their eating and cooking skills using local products. His interests include workforce development and mentoring to young men and women seeking a career in the culinary arts. He supports several fund raisers which provide services to underserved communities.

Chef Walker and his wife LaTrevette reside in Poughkeepsie.

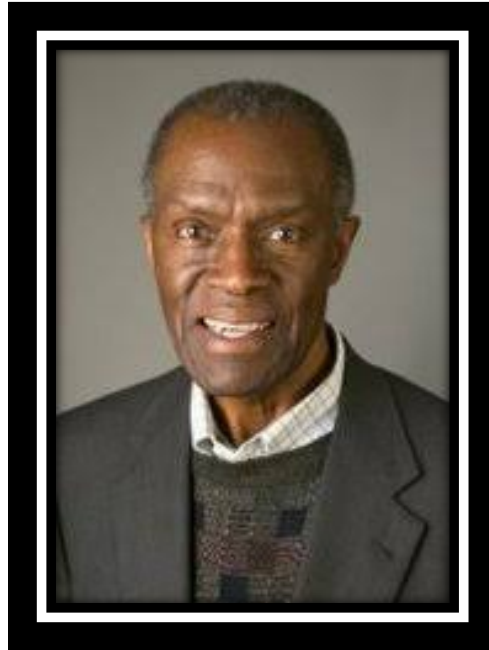

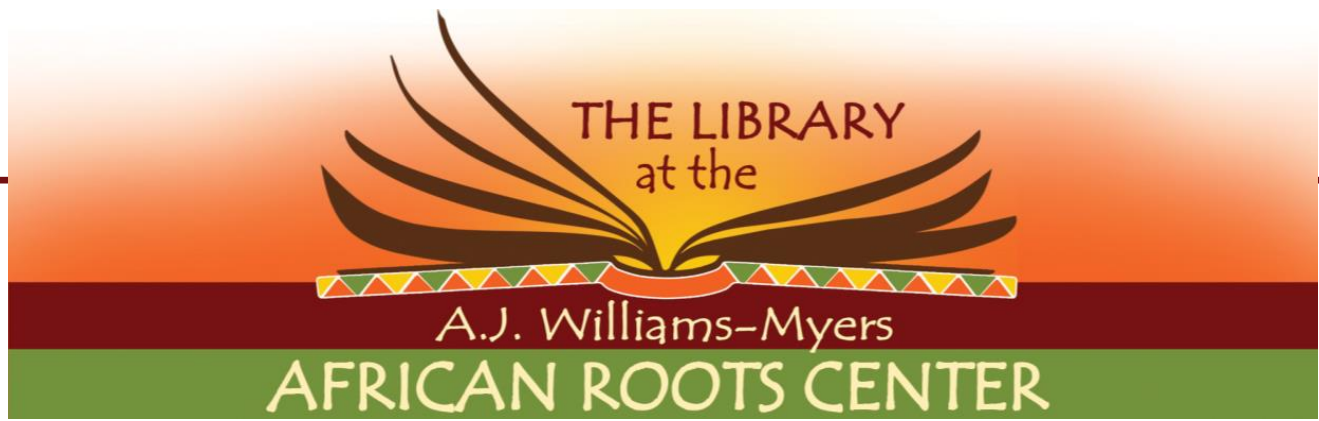
Dr. A.J. Williams-Myers

A.J. Williams-Myers holds a Ph.D in History from the University of California at Los Angeles, with a concentration in African History. Through post-graduate work, Dr. Williams-Myers broadened his historical scope to include the African Diaspora. Dr. Williams-Myers was Executive Director of the New York African American Institute, a research-oriented affiliate of the State University of New York. While there, he represented the Institute at and participated in a conference tour on AIDS in the People's Republic of China. Before assuming directorship of the Institute, Dr. Williams-Myers served as Chair of the Black Studies Department. Prior to teaching at SUNY New Paltz, he held the position of Assistant Professor of African History at Carleton College in Minnesota. Dr. Williams-Myers also served in the United States Peace Corps in Malawi, Central Africa and taught school in the U.S. Virgin Islands.

Dr. Williams-Myers has been a consultant to several educational and research projects, including the Historical Hudson Valley, City College (CUNY), and the New York Historical Society. Among Dr. Williams-Myers publications are *In Their Own Words: Voices from the Middle Passage*; *On the Morning Tide: African Americans, History and Methodology in the Historical Ebb and Flow of Hudson River Society*; and *African Dreams: To tell Their Story of Old New York*. He has also published extensively in national and international journals. African Roots Library in Kingston NY is named in his honor.

Now retired, Dr. Williams-Myers lives in New Paltz with his wife, Janice, to whom he has been married for 56 years.

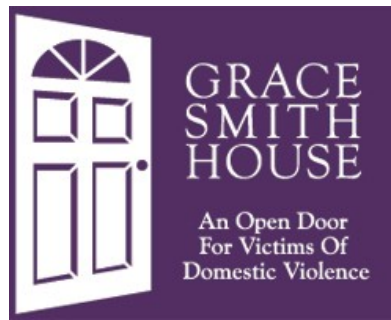
Current projects include the Newburgh Performing Arts Academy and the Poughkeepsie Performing Arts Academy where students receive high quality instruction in the various art forms including dance, music, theatre and visual arts; **The After School Project (TAP)**, a comprehensive network of afterschool programs designed to provide youth with the academic, social, and vocational competencies they will need to successfully enter college and the workforce; **SmARTS**, our summer program for youth ages 6-14 that offers arts, academic, recreation, technology and science instruction to youth five days a week during the summer months; and **Triple Play** the Boys & Girls Club's health and wellness initiative that strives to improve the overall health of members by increasing their daily physical activity, teaching them good nutrition and helping them develop healthy relationships.

For over 73 years the Boys & Girls Club has been at the forefront providing youth development services to over 25,000 youth and families since its inception and continues to serve as a safe haven and trusted community asset.

Serving Dutchess county for almost four decades, Grace Smith House is an inspiring example of how a small group of determined individuals can create positive, lasting change in their community. In the late 1970's a group of concerned citizens recognized the need for families experiencing domestic violence to have a safe place to stay. The original Grace Smith House shelter was located in a house donated by the First Presbyterian Church of Poughkeepsie on Cannon Street. Incorporated in 1981, Grace Smith House was named for Grace McComb Smith of the Smith Brothers Cough Drop family a woman ahead of her time who showed compassion to all, passion for social justice and dedication to service in her community.

The original shelter was quickly outgrown and a new 20 bed shelter was built on purchased property. Our shelter is named after the first executive director, MaryLou Hessenbottle. It became apparent that more was needed than just shelter. Families needed counseling to deal with the trauma of family violence. Now simply called our Non-residential program, we offer assistance to any individual who identifies as a victim of domestic violence in need of our help. We offer individualized trauma counseling, support groups, including one for Spanish speaking clients, children support groups and activities, case management and advocacy services. We assist with providing transportation to court, medical providers, social services. Seeing the need for services to the growing Latina population, Grace Smith House developed the Latina Outreach program to address the critical needs of victims in the Latina community.

Grace Smith House was also instrumental in partnering with Child Protective Services in Dutchess county and creating the CPS/DVL initiative in 2004. This partnership has allowed for a greater understanding and cooperation between domestic violence advocates and CPS workers., as well as better outcomes for our mutual clients. While our two groups might look at the same situation through a different lens, through our partnership and collaboration, we realize we are all working for the same result: a safe, secure, healthy family. Our advocates are fixtures at family court and each year we assist victims by writing over 1,200 petitions for orders of protection and violations. We also accompany victims to court to provide support and much needed advocacy.

Grace Smith House is also at the leading edge of prevention education. Our Healthy Teen initiative has reached every school district in Dutchess county over the past seven years with information on healthy relationships and how to help when a friend may be experiencing an unhealthy or event abusive relationship. Our work in the middle schools is in great demand as we help kids address bullying, cyberbullying and safety online. Community education extends beyond the schools. Each year we educate over a hundred healthcare providers on identifying the signs of abuse, implementing universal screening protocols and helping victims they see connect to critical services Grace Smith House is once again experiencing a period of growth in response to the needs of our community. We have expanded our shelter to 25 beds and even so, last year we turned away over 450 requests for emergency shelter. We have purchases property on which we will build an additional shelter. This purchase also allows us to expand our Non-residential program by moving non-client related administrative offices to a new location. Through all the growth we remain true to our core services and our mission. Our hotline is answered 24/7/365 by a trained advocate who can offer crisis counseling, information and referrals. Our advocates are fixtures around the community. From our grass roots beginnings, we have grown into a dedicated, professional staff of nearly 40. The passion and spirit of our staff echo the passion of our founders and is a tribute to every survivor we serve.
